



## **Hosting Announcement for Far West Regional League Fall 2011**

Applications to host Far West Regional League weekends will be accepted until June 15, 2011. The FWRL committee is seeking fall 2011 hosts for the last three weekends in August, Labor Day weekend, the last weekends in September and October, and November 12, 13. We will need multiple host sites for each weekend. Each team, club, league or state association with teams involved in the FWRL is encouraged to host fall games. Please do not sign up to host on a weekend that your team is not committed to play.

November 19 and 20 is the weekend for the FWRL playoffs. If your field is not centrally located in the region, you will not be selected to host the playoffs. Submit an application for that weekend if you wish, however, in case your team or club is involved in a bracket that has round robin play on November 19 and 20.

Potential host sites should submit site-host agreements by June 15. Sites may be finalized at any time during the next two months. The final list of playing sites will be determined in June and posted immediately. Teams, clubs or leagues wishing to host FWRL weekends must contact their state association for any local guidelines concerning hosting requirements. It is the intent of the FWRL that local teams absorb the cost of hosting, as travel costs are eliminated. Many Southern California sites have already been contracted by the FWRL staff. The costs for those sites will be divided among Cal South teams and each team will be billed for their portion. The costs for Arizona sites will also be cumulated and divided amongst the Arizona teams.
