



Policy on Reschedule of Games

There are two types of scheduling for the Far West Regional League: 1) Self-scheduled games agreed upon by the coaches in the same geographic area, and 2) Games scheduled involving teams that must travel. These are typically, but not limited to, mandatory play date weekends.

Self-scheduled games must be scheduled by September 10 and played by November 13. They will be entered into the master schedule and can only be rescheduled through the FWRL committee. Mutual coach agreement, host site approval and a firm field commitment will be necessary for the consideration of a rescheduling request after September 10, 2011.

Games scheduled involving teams that must travel, and the mandatory play date weekends, are not eligible for reschedule except under very limited circumstances. The parameters above must be met and a clear demonstration that third party teams will not be affected is required. A notable exception is that two local teams scheduled to play the last game on Sunday at an away location can reschedule that game to a local venue just by mutual coach agreement.

Conflicts regarding non-affiliated organizations will not be considered. Contact the FWRL Commissioner to start any rescheduling process. In all cases, please do not reschedule any games on your own. Thanks in advance for your cooperation.
