### **First day results from US Youth Soccer ODP Boys 1992 Winter Interregional**

**WILSON, N.C. (Dec. 11, 2009)** - The US Youth Soccer Olympic Development Program (US Youth Soccer ODP) Boys 1992 Winter Interregional kicked off today at Wilson Gillette Soccer Complex in Wilson, N.C. The US Youth Soccer ODP Boys 1992 Interregional event is being held in conjunction with the NCAA Division I College Cup Championships and the opening weekend of the US Youth Soccer National League Boys season to provide greater exposure of these elite players to collegiate and national team coaches.

US Youth Soccer ODP Boys 1992 Region III came back from an early 2-0 deficit before Region IV took over once again in the second half to give the westerners a 4-2 win in their opening game. Ian Ramos put Region IV up early at the 10 minute mark and John Crenshaw extended the lead to 2-0 in the 31<sup>st</sup>. Justin Portillo pulled Region III back into the game with a goal four minutes later and in the second half Michael Derbecker leveled the score in the 53<sup>rd</sup>. Region IV regained their form as the second half wore on and reestablished their two goal lead with goals from Ramos and Dustin Corea just seconds apart in the 72<sup>nd</sup> to give Region IV a 4-2 victory over Region III.
