

## **Parking**

No parking fees will be collected on-site for parking at the 2007 US Youth Soccer Far West Regional Championships. A parking surcharge is being collected as a part of the entry fees for participation in the 2007 event in Las Vegas. This allows for free entry into the parking areas at both sites during the event itself.

Parking at the Bettye Wilson Soccer Complex will be available across the street from the complex, on the grounds of Cimarron Memorial High School. Parking at Cimarron Memorial High School will be restricted to the south lot, facing the Bettye Wilson Soccer Complex. **No parking will be allowed on the north side of the school.** Parking at the lot closest to Bettye Wilson will be limited to tournament staff, handicapped and VIP parking. Parking passes will be required for this lot. No passes will be required for general parking.

Please note that summer school will be in session at Cimarron Memorial High School during the tournament. As a result, some parking spots in the south parking lot may be reserved for students attending summer school. If you see any spots that are condoned off for school parking, please refrain from parking in those spots.

**If you are bringing a recreational vehicle, team bus or other over-sized vehicle, please see the information posted regarding parking for these vehicles under the heading “Recreational Vehicles and Buses”.**

At Kellogg Zaher, the parking lot runs the length of the complex. All but a few designated spots near fields K5 and K6 are available for general parking. Ample handicapped parking is available near each entrance to the game fields. As with Bettye Wilson, no parking passes are required at Kellogg Zaher for general parking.

Please note that when parking at Kellogg Zaher, there are three entrances to the complex off of Washington. The entrance that is furthest east is closest to fields K7 to K11, the entrance furthest west is closest to fields K1 to K3, and the center entrance is closest to fields K4 to K6. Entering the park nearer to your assigned field will give you the best chance of parking close to your field. For fields K10 and K11, there is a separate lot at the easternmost end of the complex that is very convenient to these fields. This lot can only be entered while traveling east on Washington. VIP and staff parking at Kellogg Zaher can best be accessed by entering the center entrance off of Washington (this entrance is an extension of Cimarron Road). The first row of parking stalls to your left once you enter the park will be designated at Staff and VIP parking. Parking passes must be displayed to park in this area.

## **Recreational Vehicles and Buses**

At the Bettye Wilson Soccer Complex, recreational vehicles, team buses or other oversized vehicles must be parked at the lot adjacent to the “West 20”. **Due to parking constraints at the Cimarron Memorial High School parking lot, no oversized vehicles will be allowed to park in that lot.** To get to the lot at the West 20, you will head north from Lake Mead Blvd. on Buffalo. Turn right on Caliche Way. At the point where Caliche Way terminates a few hundred yards east of Buffalo, the West 20 will be on your left. There is parking for the West 20 located to your left. **Do not park behind the storefronts on your right.**

Coming from the West 20, Bettye Wilson can be easily accessed on foot. To get to the Bettye Wilson, you will proceed east from the parking lot at the West 20 toward the northwest end of the soccer complex. Immediately ahead, you will see a small bridge over a flood control channel. Proceeding over this bridge will take you to Bettye Wilson. The soccer complex is clearly in view from the West 20 parking lot.

At the Kellogg Zaher Sports Complex, oversized vehicles must be parked in the row of parking stalls furthest to the north on the parking lots. To avoid parking shortages at the complex, we are asking that these vehicles, however, be minimized. If parking problems occur due to the number of oversized vehicles brought to the event, we will require all oversized vehicles to be moved to an overflow lot to the west of the Kellogg Zaher Sports Complex.

If any owners of recreational vehicles have a desire to park their vehicles overnight at either complex, you must call us in advance for instructions. We have received special dispensation from the City of Las Vegas that may allow a limited number of these vehicles to remain either at the West 20 lot (Bettye Wilson) or at Kellogg Zaher on an overnight basis.
