

## **Team Warm-up Area at the Bettye Wilson Soccer Complex**

The Host Organizing Committee would like to let the teams scheduled to play games at the Bettye Wilson Soccer Complex during the 2007 Far West Regionals know that an area to the immediate west of the soccer complex has been secured to serve as a pre-game warm-up area. Since on-field warm-up is generally very limited prior to Regional Championship matches, this area provides a good alternative. This area, known locally as the "West 20", can be accessed in one of two ways.

By car, you will head north from Lake Mead Blvd. on Buffalo. Turn right on Caliche Way. At the point where Caliche Way terminates a few hundred yards east of Buffalo, the West 20 will be on your left. There is parking for the West 20 located to your left. Do not park behind the storefronts on your right.

If you are parked at the Bettye Wilson Soccer Complex, the West 20 can also be accessed on foot. To get to the West 20, you will proceed west along the northern fence line of the Bettye Wilson Soccer Complex. Immediately ahead, you will see a small bridge over a flood control channel. Proceeding over this bridge will take you to the West 20. The West 20 is clearly in view from the Bettye Wilson Soccer Complex.
